

Biography

Sarah Bracke is Professor of Sociology of Gender and Sexuality at the University of Amsterdam. She is the PI of *EnGendering Europe's 'Muslim Question'*, a research project funded by the Dutch Research Council, which investigates the systematic problematization of Muslims in Europe and how questions of gender and sexuality are grounds for such problematization. She directed the Amsterdam Research Centre for Gender and Sexuality between 2019-2022 and is one of the coordinators of the Research Priority Area *Decolonial Futures* at the University of Amsterdam. Her most recent publication includes a volume on *The Politics of Replacement. Demographic Fears, Conspiracy Theories, and Race Wars* (Routledge, forthcoming) and is working on a book manuscript on the 'Muslim Question' in Europe, together with Luis Hernández Aguilar. She is also the Sociology Executive Editor of the Sage journal *Ethnography*.
